Dear Parent or Educator:

As part of our ongoing efforts to educate area high school students about healthcare careers, Brooks Memorial Hospital will again be hosting a Healthcare Careers Summer Camp at the Hospital in Dunkirk this summer. This educational program will be held on August 24, 25 & 26, and is designed to provide information and job shadowing opportunities for students considering a career in the healthcare field. CPR Training will also be offered to any students who are interested. This free program is open to students who have completed at least the 10th grade as of June 2010. This includes students who will be Juniors or Seniors in the Fall 2010 school year, and students who will be graduating in June 2010. *If space allows, younger students may also be considered.*

This information is being sent to you because of your previously expressed interest in this type of program at Brooks. Applications must be returned by June 25, **along with a copy of the students Cumulative Health Record**. *Students must provide documentation that they are current with all of their immunizations, including 2 dates of MMR, Chicken Pox vaccine, and a TB test within the past 12 months.* The hospital will be unable to perform this testing for the students and applications cannot be considered without it. Encourage your students to get this information together ASAP!

We will be reviewing applications, selecting participants, and sending out acceptance letters in early July. A maximum of 15 students can be accommodated in this program, so students are encouraged to get their applications in as early as possible. ***Only applications that include all required health documentation can be considered for acceptance.***
